

Are Hostels safe?

13 personal safety tips for staying at a Hostel



- 1. Stay at a hostel with a secure hostel location Choose a quality hostel and not the cheapest one - all 5 Star Hostels are safe!
- 2. Trust your gut and use your head avoid situations you are not comfortable with
- 3. Arrive to the hostel first-time before dark
- 4. Use always the provided lockers (even in private rooms)
- 5. Ask staff for security advice (even before arrival via email or phone)
- 6. If in doubt, travel in a group
- 7. Don't open the hostel door for strangers
- 8. Don't bring shady friends to the house
- 9. Watch your belongings you care about
- 10. Copy your Passport and email it to you
- 11. Hide some backup money in a different pocket
- 12. For Female Traveler: if in doubt, many hostels offer female-only dorms as well. There are even complete hostels only for female traveler.
- 13. Drink responsibly (and in a group)
